



## Human Library Local Organizers TERMS FOR USE of the Human Library™

Local organizers are obligated to make clear reference to source in written and online materials. Please include the attached logo on materials produced for the event.

We ask that you make your experiences available to other organizers by submitting a short report of your event including statistics containing information about the amount of loans, readers and books available at the event.

We ask that you commit to submitting the short report about the outcomes and statistics for the event no later than 30 days after the event.

That you accept that we list you, on the Human Library Organization website, as an official local organizer and that you are obligated to inform us of any future events, so that we can register your activities, update our calendar and promote your events.

That you do not enter into agreement with any commercial sponsor/s to be marketed alongside with the event, without prior written approval from the Human Library Organization.

It is not allowed to hire people to be books. Under certain circumstances compensation for loss of salary can be accepted. However in general the living books are to be composed only of volunteers and/or representatives from organizations, institutions or public authorities.

It is not allowed to charge money for the services of the Human Library. This refers not only to readers, but also as a service rendered to third party. It is however allowed to stage events at a festival or other cultural event, where it is necessary to pay to enter.

Finally that you agree to respect that the Human/Living Library concept and methodology is not in any way to be used for commercial purposes and that the services of the Human Library are to remain free to its readers.

You are not allowed to charge the public or any other entity such as private companies or organisations, for the services of the Human Library.

Any deviation from the conditions listed in this document are subject to prior written approval by the Human Library Organization.

With your application to host an event, you confirm that you have read and accepted the above listed terms of use and that you will do your utmost to uphold these terms.
